#### ABOUT OUR ORGANIZATION

The Nation Edge is committed to creating an educated society that stands on the trinity of equality, justice, and freedom. To ensure we achieve our goal, we work with likeminded organizations and young minds of our country to build an educated society where no child is left behind due to financial or other impediments. We create platforms through which youth can voice their opinions and contribute to the process of social development through their knowledge and innovative ways to solve the problems of inclusion and equity in access to education.

The Nation Edge is a registered, non-profit Charitable Trust formed in 2019, based out of Agra, intending to advance quality education and the health/wellbeing of children in India without any kind of discrimination.

Our work strategy includes conducting public campaigns led by volunteers, changemakers, and our partners, empowering local communities, and raising awareness about critical social issues. We strive to create linkages between local government, administration, politicians, and other stakeholders to address issues of inequity in access to primary education, especially among girls and motivate local community members and youth to act as changemakers by contributing to their local community to ensure economically and socially backward sections of the society get formal education.

We believe that primary education is a must for all, as also enlisted in the Indian Constitution as a Fundamental Right under Article 21-A. An empowered and financially independent individual is built on the foundations of an educated child. It requires not just formal education but an education that gives core importance to interactive teaching/learning modules. In addition to collaborating with small schools, we work with the children of all sections of society. The Nation Edge mobilizes them for better behaviors and acts as a role model in their own family and society to reduce poverty.

#### **OUR CAMPAIGNS**

#### **❖** Yoga for a Healthier Life

The Nation Edge believes in encouraging a healthy lifestyle and inculcating healthy practices right from childhood among children such as meditation, yoga, physical exercise. This leads to building a stronger, healthier and mentally stronger youth. Since our physical health is deeply correlated to our mental and emotional health, we try to raise awareness among children about the same through our Yoga camps and online Yoga webinars/classes. #### **❖** Aadhaar Card Camp by Indian Post Payment Bank

Indian Post Payment Bank and The Nation Edge organized a camp to help the socially and economically underprivileged people get their Aadhaar cards made. Since an Aadhaar card acts as

an identification number that allows them to access several government schemes, we realized that many beneficiaries often do not get access to those government services or schemes due to a lack of having an Aadhaar card. We wanted to remove this obstacle to accessing government schemes and services therefore India Post Payment Bank officials came forward to help us organize Aadhaar camps. Through this exercise, we were able to help hundreds of people to access basic goods and services, which they deserve as a means to improve their life.



#### **\*** Health Camps

The Nation Edge organized a health camp at St. Learning Convent School in partnership with Accuprobe Labs Pvt Ltd. We educated children about common communicable diseases and how they can prevent themselves. We also helped them understand the use of Over-the counter

medicines for common diseases such as fever, cold and cough.





#### **❖** Book-Set Distribution by our Book Bank

The Nation Edge understands that access to formal education comes with a few costs, such as tuition fees, uniform prices, stationery, and book costs. Since we are partnering with schools in low-income communities, we have observed that parents are eager to get their wards educated

and enrolled at a school but find it difficult to fund other costs attached. Our volunteers, therefore, decided to support parents by distributing book sets at the start of their academic calendar. Our donors and volunteers came forward to establish a book bank to act as a mobile library for the schools closely associated with The Nation Edge.





#### Distribution of Blankets among the homeless

The Nation Edge understands that north Indian winters can be excruciatingly painful for the homeless people, finding it hard to keep themselves warm. We decided to distribute blankets among the homeless and in this initiative we were supported by 'Manav Kalyan-Sanshadhan Vikas Samiti'. #### **❖** Distribution of utilities at Orphanage

To cater to different strata of society, The Nation Edge tries to diversify its contributions and therefore, our team partnered with 'Matra Chhaya' orphanage home, to understand their needs and issues. Catering to the needs, our team with active help from volunteers and donors distributed basic utility items such as biscuits, mosquito repellents, diapers, lotions, among other things.






• Our young volunteer is seen sharing safety rules among his peers. This helps to build confidence and interpersonal skills among children at the right age.









❖ A father of one of the students studying in standard II- Anu Mishra at St. Learning Convent School, writes to the Principal of the school to thank him for the support provided by him
